

The meeting was held using the Zoom Meeting App. The orientation programme for the online certification course was held on October 10th, 2021. Dr. Manoj Swaminathan, founder/director of the vigiserve foundation, has been invited as the Main Speaker for this session. Dr. Manoj Swaminathan explored all the facts regarding the history, introduction, and career options in pharmacovigilance in his session.

We invited seven lecturers to talk throughout the online course. Mr. Vivek Chakole, Lead TCS, Nagpur, joined us as a guest speaker on October 14th, 2021. He explained data input, medical coding, narrative writing, causality evaluation, and labelling of the adverse event. On October 17th, 2021, we invited Dr. Shrinivas Sharma, who works at the PMS.RM. He addressed aggregate report writing, signal and risk management of product information, and review of regulatory recommendations.

Mr. Vikas Gangurde, Senior Consultant, Business Consulting Infosys, Pune, was invited as a guest speaker on October 23rd, 2021. He provided thorough details about Pharmacovigilance, Quality Assurance, Internal audits and Regulatory inspections. Mr. Vikas Gangurde provided thorough information regarding Pharmacovigilance requirements in Europe, the United States, Canada, Australia, and India on October 22nd, 2021. We asked a guest speaker, Pankaj Wadibhasme, a Senior Medical Writer from Mumbai, to talk on October 30th, 2021. He provided thorough information and guidance on how to build up a master file in a pharmacovigilance system. We invited Mr. Anand Attal, Team Manager Labcorp Drug Development Ltd. Pune, to speak on November 3rd, 2021. He shared detailed information and advised on fresher trainings for non-pharmacovigilance staff, as well as training record maintenance. Dr. Satish A. Polshettiwar, Associate Professor and Head Career Services School of Pharmacy MIT World Peace University Pune, was invited to lecture on November 6th, 2021. He gave detailed information and guidance on interview questions, mock interviews, and pharmacovigilance career opportunities.
