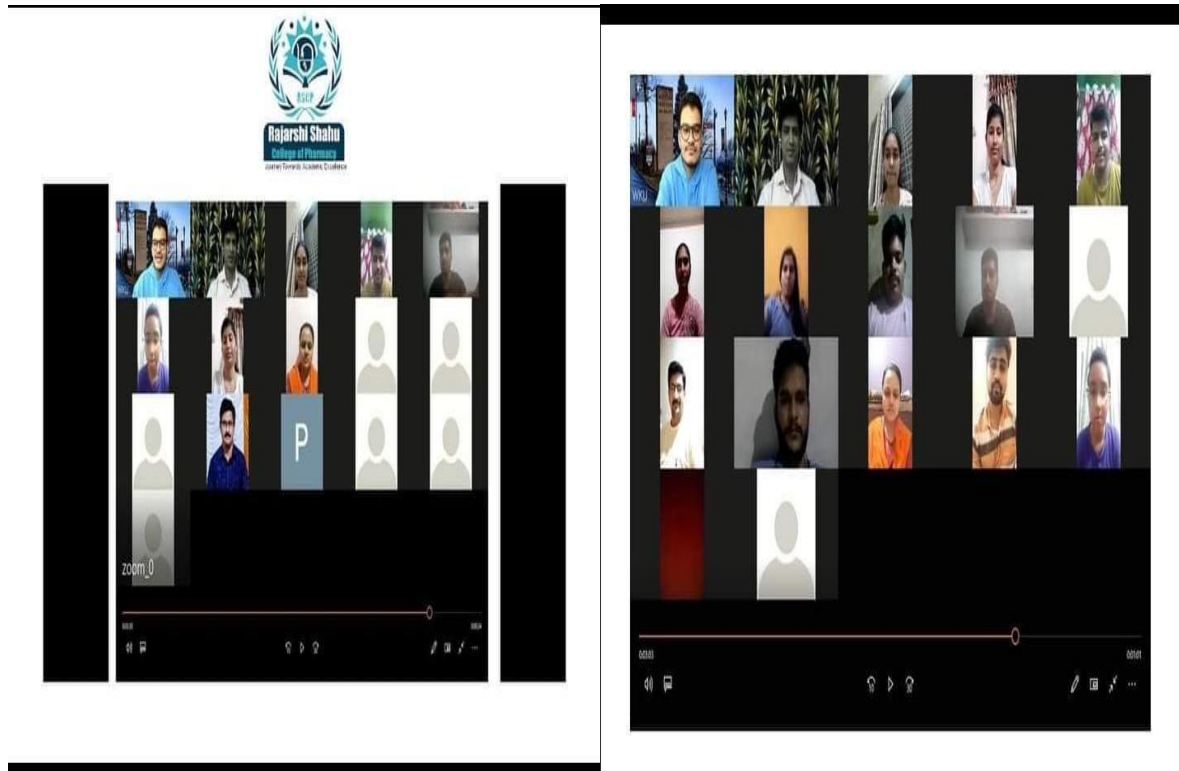

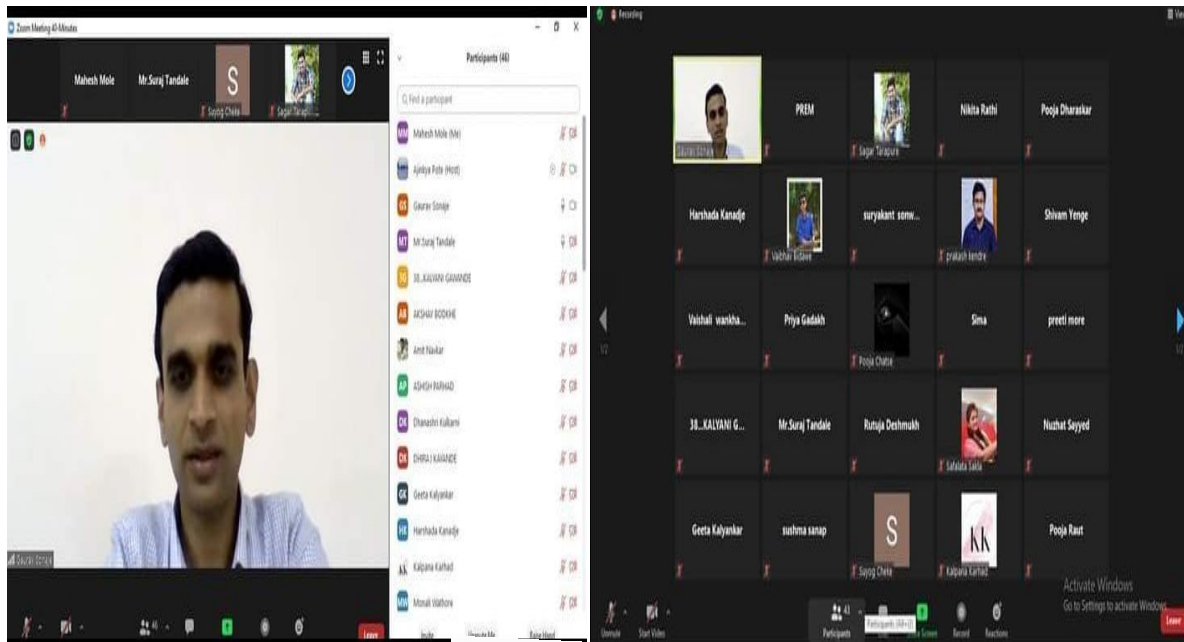


In valedictory, organisers were honored by offering bouquet. All the faculty members actively worked in local organizing committee.




