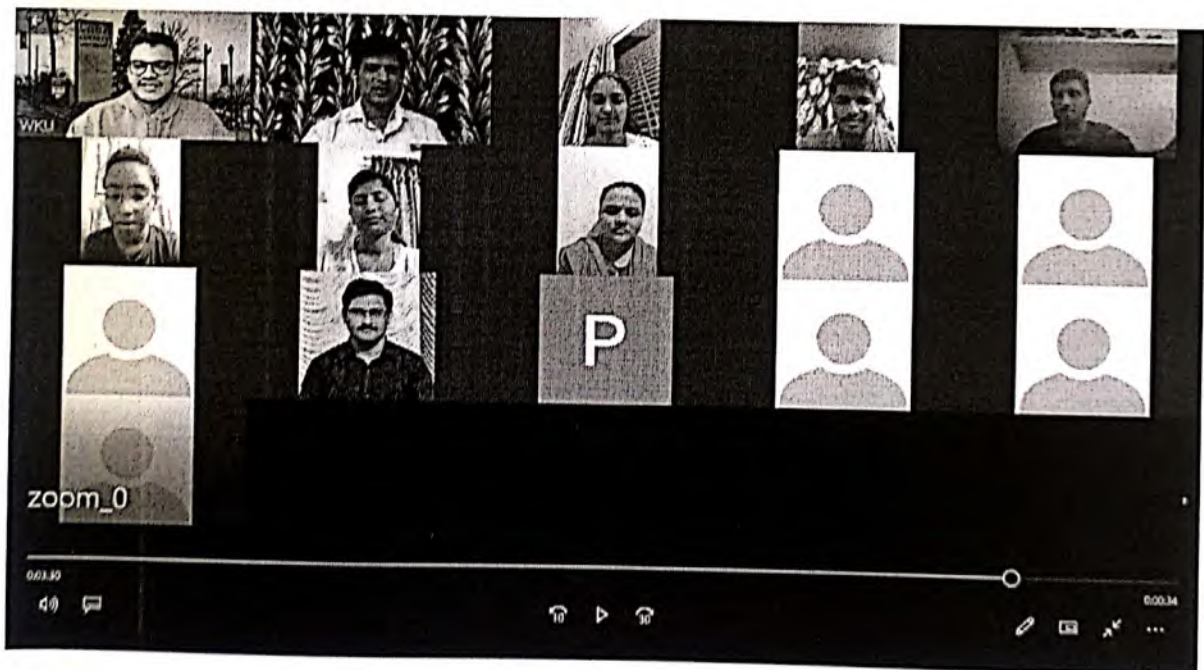

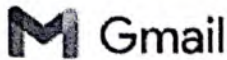

\* The Title

- The title for presentation should be effective and written with bold fonts with the proper alignments on the slide.

- There should be a signature on the slide i.e. college logo, company logo.

\* Do's & Don'ts of slide preparation

\* Do's -

- The slide should have proper layout according to the need such as heading, comparison, etc.

- The slide should have bullet points.

- The slide should have flow charts, comparison tables which explains the topic in short.

- The font in slide should be big enough for audience on last row should.

- The points in the slide should have numbering as the option is available which makes it easier for audience.

- The use of images, videos, sounds can make the slide effective and easy to understand.
- It should have some questions for the audience.

### \* Dont's -

- The slide should not have long paragraph.
- The slide should not have grammatical mistakes.
- Don't use fancy colours and fonts in official presentation.
- Exception - for advertisement of product.
- The slide should not have the unnecessary animations.

### \* The 10 20 30 rule

- The 10 in the rule stands for number of slides.  
The number of slides should not exceed more than 10 slides.
- The 20 in the rule stands for 20 minutes.  
ie the duration of presentation.
- The 30 in the rule stands for font number ie 30.
- The font should not be less than 30. The font should be 30.





### \* 6 x 6 rule

- This rule as per name indicates 6, not more than 6 points on the slide.
- The each point should have not more than 6 words.

### \* Conclusion

- Always be remember, you should be talkative more than your slide.
- Avoid just reading the slide.
- You should be confident during presentation.
- Be interactive with the audience, by asking questions.
- While delivering presentation you should maintain eye contact with audience.
- At the end of presentation ask for the doubts about the topic.
