- 10. In case of attending/presenting poster at Symposia, the maximum amount of **Rs.5000/-** will be funded by the institute. Funding amount more than above specified, in special case will be only considered with positive after remark of ARC and Principal. Original bills have to produce to account section to disburse the amount.


