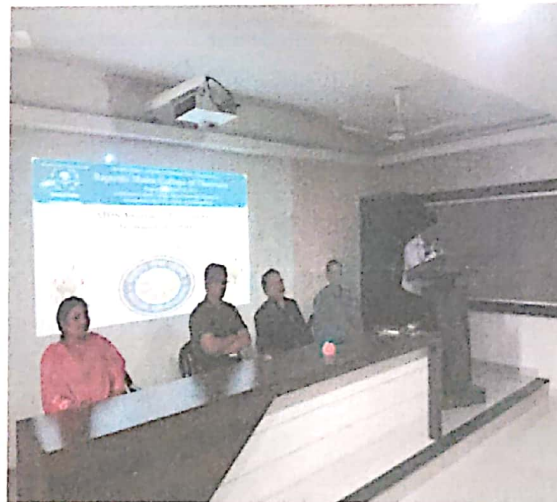


### **Summary**
