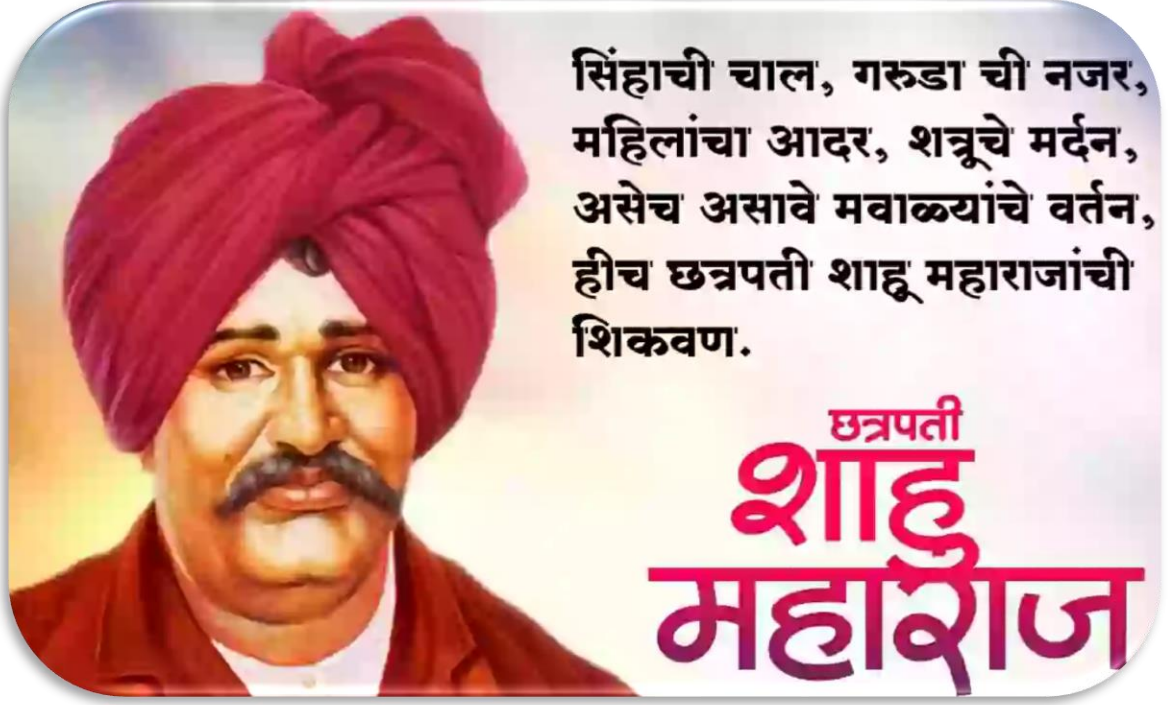

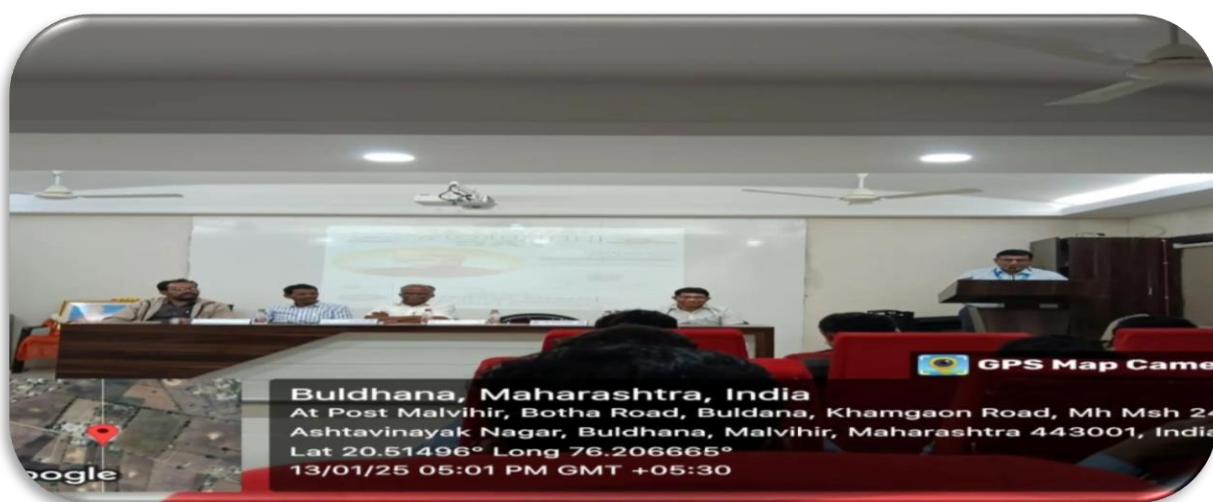
12th January: National Youth day Celebration Day

Overall, the Alumni Meet 2025 reinforced the bond between alumni and their alma mater, promoting lifelong learning and collaboration.



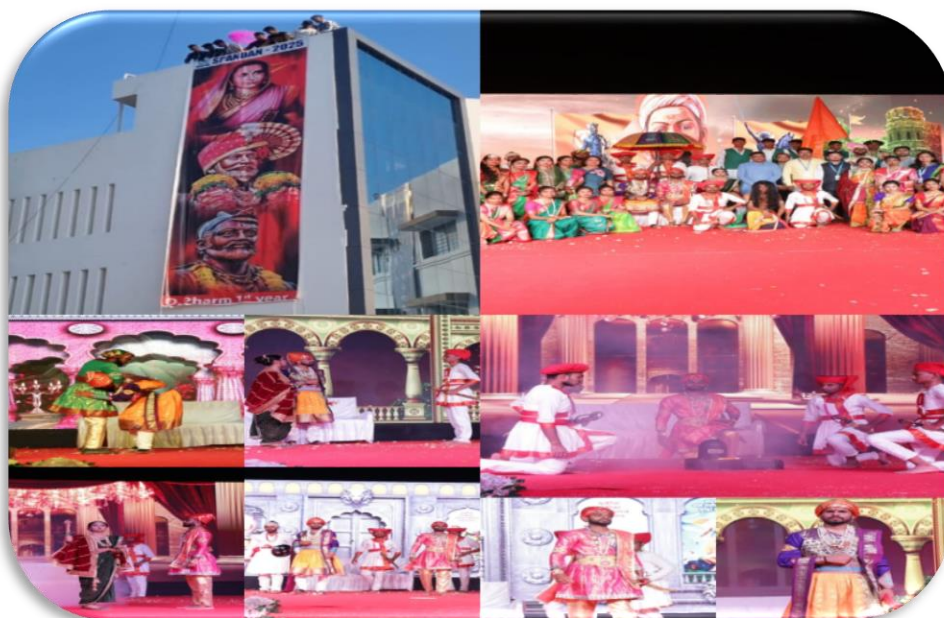

All staff member, supporting staff, office staff were enthusiastically involved in this program.

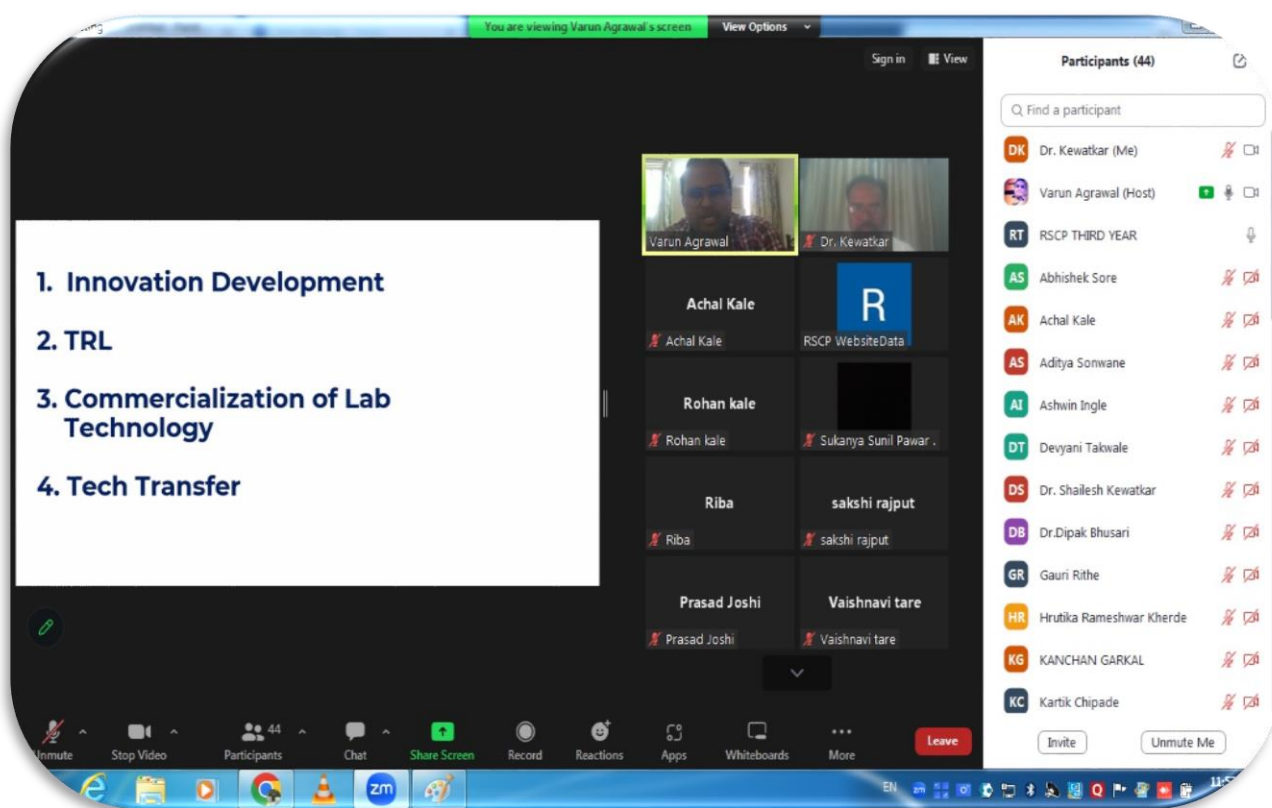

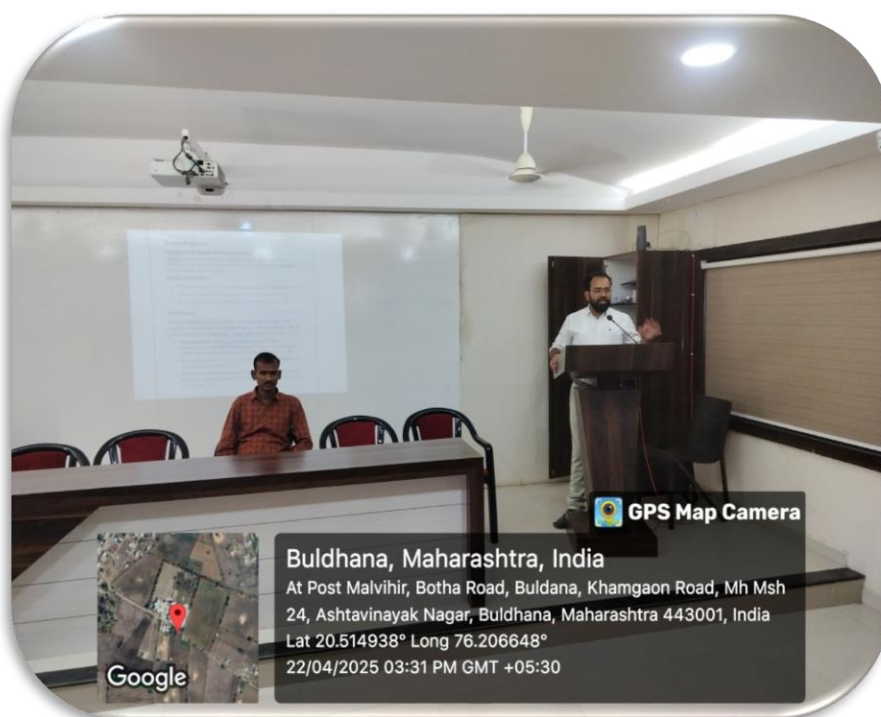
22nd April: Awareness program on Competitive Exams

This seminar aimed to equip Pharma graduates with knowledge about the rapidly evolving IT healthcare industry and the diverse career paths available to them.



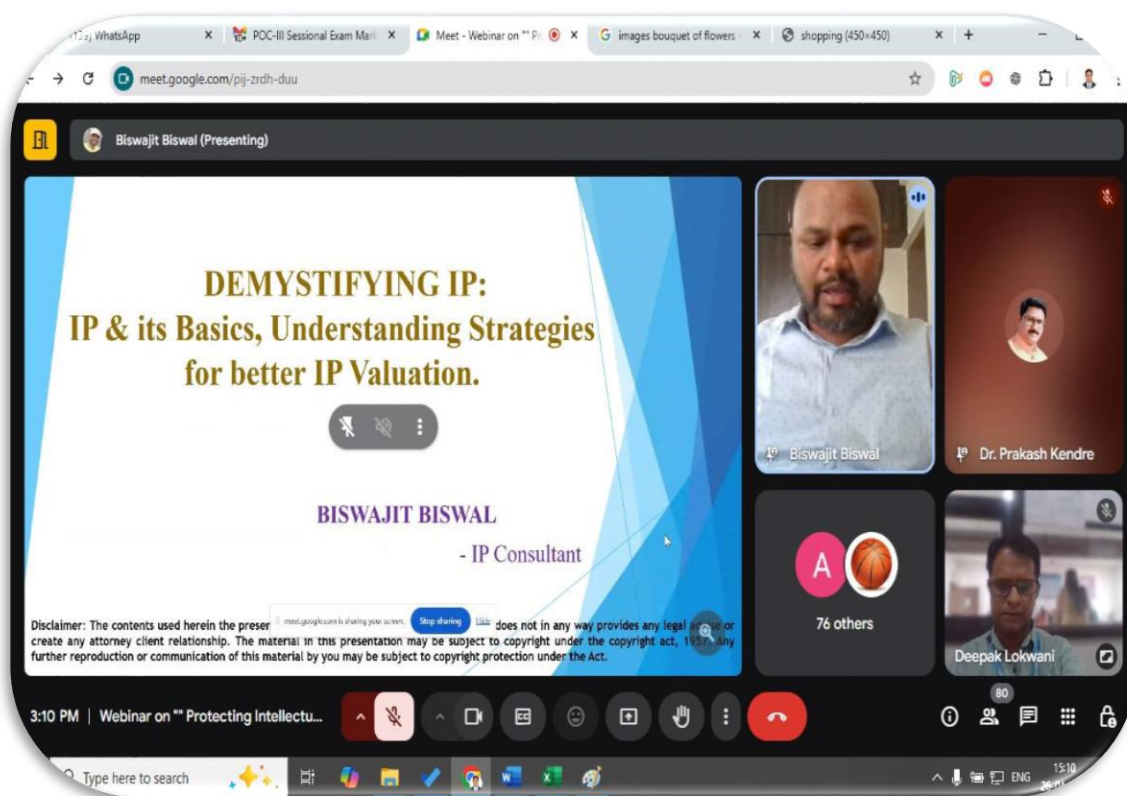

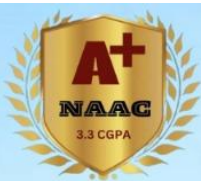
