
# Message from Hon'ble Chairman

#### 1 May: Celebration of Maharashtra Divas and Labour Day








#### 3 May: Online Session on How to plan for Start-up and Legal & Ethical Steps










## 11 August: Online session on "Innovation/ Prototype Validation-Converting Innovations into a start-up"






